## O.C.B.A. POINT TOURNAMENTS MONEY POT & POT-O-GOLD RULES

## MONEY POT RULES

- 1. Money pots only apply to point tournaments.
- 2. Donation will be \$5.00 per member per tournament.
- 3. All donations <u>must be paid in cash in full prior to the start of the tournament</u> (unless approved by the Money Pot God). Correct change is appreciated!!!
- 4. If you are unable to fish a tournament for any reason, your donation will be refunded to you at a later date.
- 5. **75%** of the donations go to the Big Stringer.
- 6. 25% of the donations go to the Big Fish.
- 7. In case of a tie for Big Stringer, the largest fish in the creel will break all ties. If a tie still exists, then the donations will be divided equally.
- 8. If a tie for Big Fish exists, then the donations will be divided equally.
- 9. The Tournament Director has the right to select a member of his committee to collect and distribute the donations

## POT-O-GOLD RULES

- 1. Pot-O-Gold only applies to point tournaments.
- 2. Donation will be \$2.00 per person per tournament (\$14.00/year).
- 3. All donations must be paid in full prior to the start of the first tournament.
- 4. There will be NO REFUNDS.
- 5. All donations will accumulate until a 5 pound or greater bass is weighed in. We will count actual weight. There will be no deductions for dead fish. Only donations accumulated for those tournaments fished prior to a 5 pound or greater bass will be given out. The pot starts over again (with the remaining donations) at the next tournament.
- 6. If more than one angler brings in a 5 pound or greater bass to the scales in any one tournament, then the donations are divided equally among them.
- 7. If there are no other 5 pound or greater bass weighed in for the rest of the season, the remaining donations will be given to the member weighing in the largest bass.
- 8. If no 5 pound or greater bass are weighed in for the season, then the donations go to the member (or members-split equally) weighing in the largest bass of the year.
- **9.** The Tournament Director has the right to select a member of his committee to collect and distribute the donations.
